What is international credit mobility?

- International opening of Erasmus
- 135,000 grants over 6 years
- For students & staff (for learning & teaching & training)
- Action managed by National Agencies located in Programme Countries

Types and duration

- All levels (short cycle, Bachelor, Master, PhD)
- All disciplines
- Students: 3 months (or academic term) to 12 months
- Staff: 5 days to 2 months

Mobility based on agreements

- **Inter-institutional agreements** fix mobility flows & conditions
- - signed before mobility starts

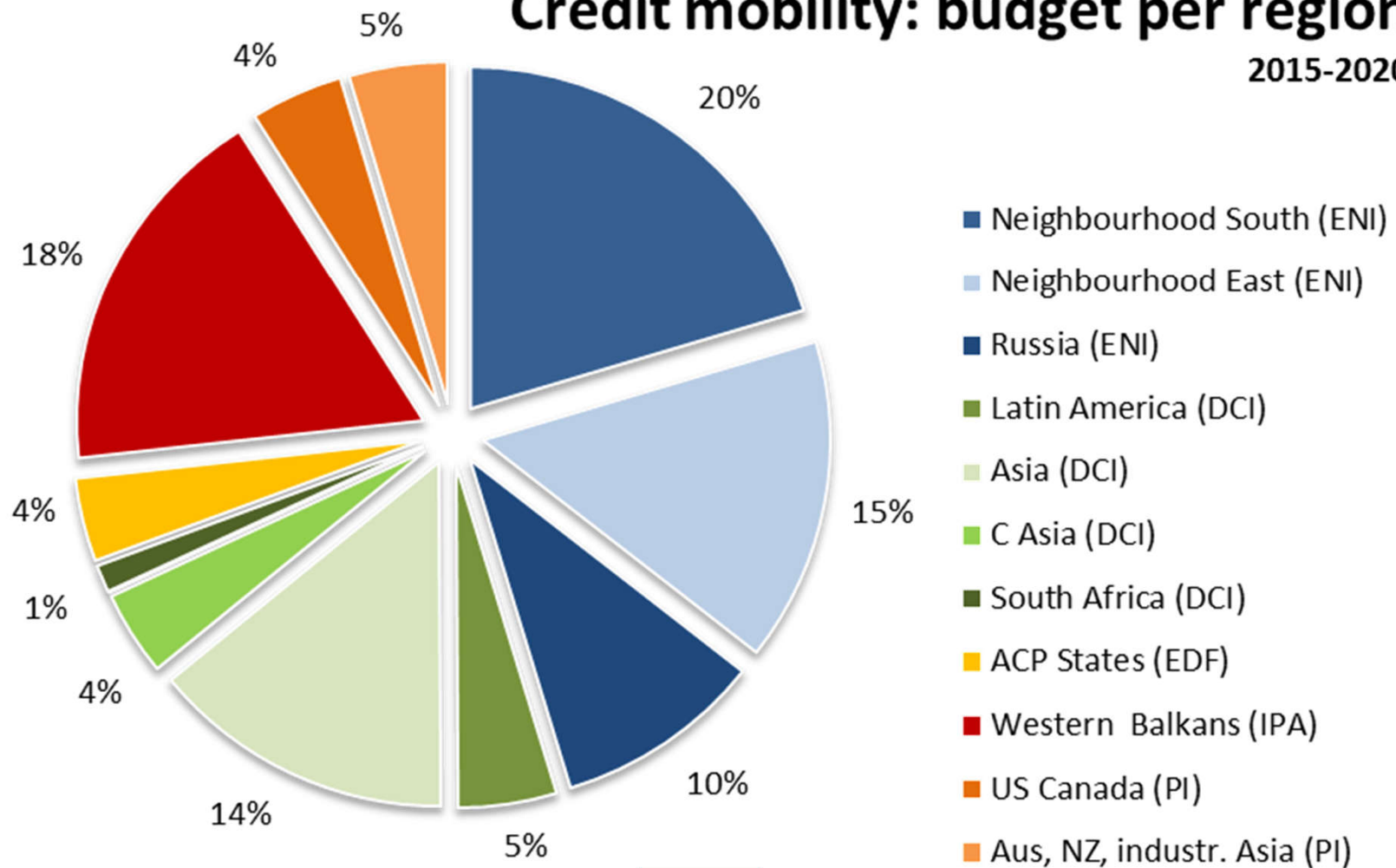
