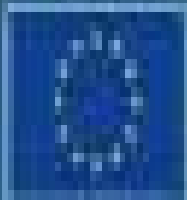

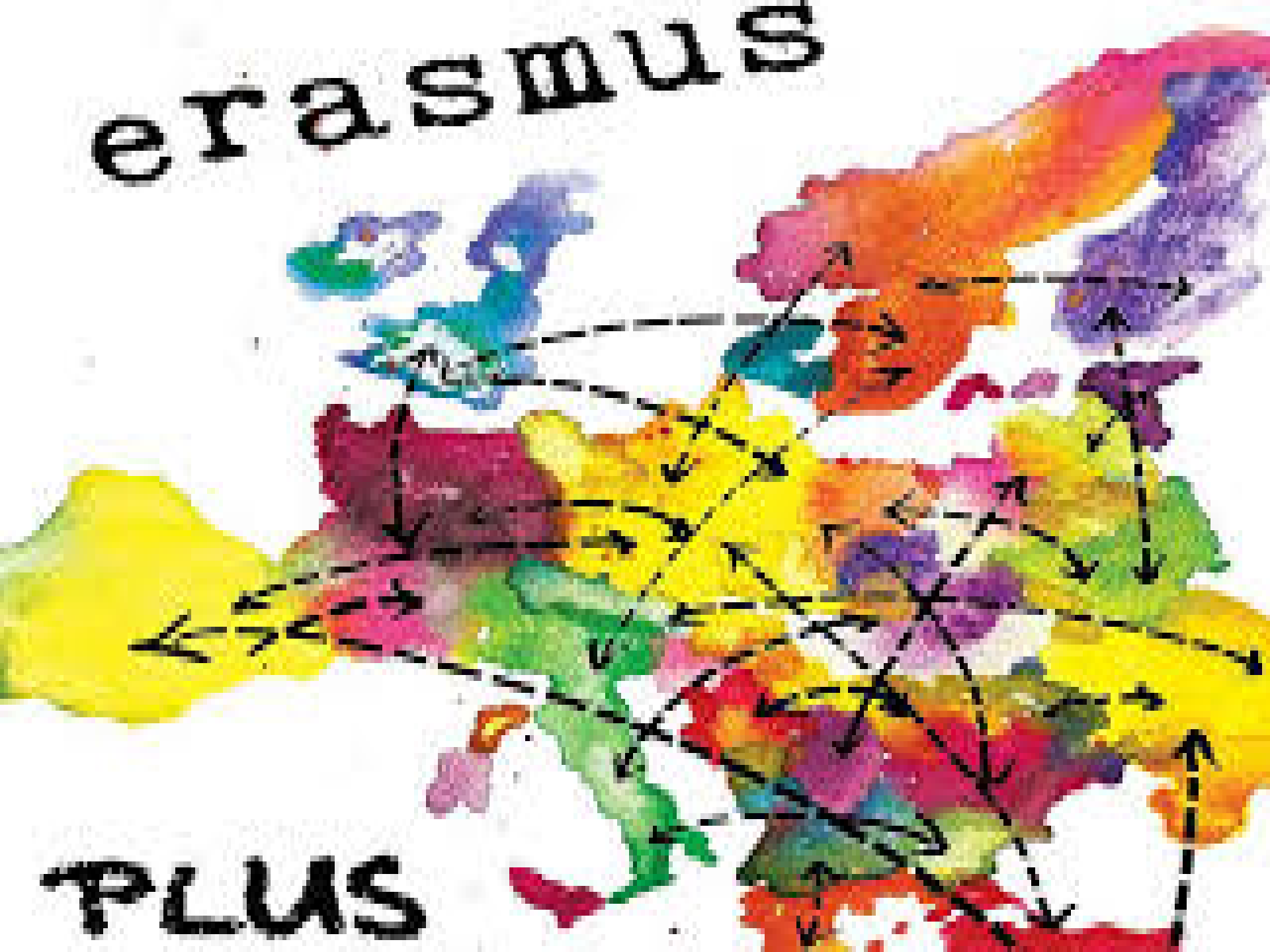
Erasmus+
