## Acquire a world-class education in information security!

SECCLO Master's Programme in Security and Cloud Computing is a two-year engineering programme (120 ECTS) which gives its students a broad understanding of the latest and future technologies for secure cloud and mobile computing systems. Students will gain both practical engineering knowledge and theoretical insights into

- secure systems engineering,
- distributed application development,
- network and service architectures, and
- cloud and mobile platforms.

### Two countries, two universities, two MSc degrees

The SECCLO students will gain a unique experience of studying in two different European countries. They graduate with a double degree.

The first-year studies (60 ECTS) at *Aalto University*, Finland, conclude with a summer school and a summer internship. For the second year, students choose from five different specialization options offered by five different universities.

The second-year specialization options are:

- *Communications Systems* (KTH, Sweden),
- *Information Security* (NTNU, Norway),
- *Reliable Distributed Systems* (DTU, Denmark),
- *Cryptography* (University of Tartu, Estonia)
- *Big Data Security* (EURECOM, France).

### Erasmus Mundus scholarships

Erasmus Mundus scholarships are available for outstanding European and non-European students to cover their participation, travel, and living costs.
